Are InTerra products compliant with the 2025 NDAA?

Yes. InTerra products are designed to comply with the applicable provisions of the 2025 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA).

Which InTerra products does this apply to?

This applies to all InTerra solutions, including SmarTarget®, Datum™, and Locator™.

Do InTerra products contain NDAA-restricted components?

No. InTerra products do not contain restricted telecommunications, video surveillance, drone flight control, or imaging components as defined under Section 889 of the NDAA.

Does InTerra manufacture drones or drone flight systems?

No. InTerra does not manufacture drones, flight controllers, cameras, or onboard communications systems.

How are InTerra products used in drone operations?

InTerra products function as ground-based reference hardware and post-processing software and operate independently of any aircraft platform.

Can InTerra products be used with NDAA-compliant drones?

Yes. InTerra products may be used alongside NDAA-compliant drones and sensors without introducing NDAA compliance risk.

Are InTerra products sourced from NDAA-restricted suppliers?

InTerra does not knowingly source or integrate components from entities restricted under Section 889 of the NDAA.
